Scheduling Your WakeMed COVID-19 Testing Appointment

Keeping all those in our care safe is a priority for WakeMed. With this in mind, we require all adults and children who are scheduled for a surgery or other procedure in a WakeMed hospital to have a COVID-19 screening and test no more than 72 hours before their appointment. After testing, please self isolate as much as possible until your surgery or procedure. IMPORTANT: Inform your physician/surgeon if you developed new symptoms since your test so you can be retested.

WakeMed has testing centers in Cary and Clayton for pre-procedure patients age 6 and older. Parents of patients younger than 6 should talk to their pediatric provider to obtain testing for their child. Please schedule your COVID-19 test for 2 or 3 days before your procedure at your preferred location. Using WakeMed MyChart is the best way to schedule your appointment and receive test results. If you have a WakeMed MyChart account:

- Log into your account
- Click on the 'Appointments' tab
- Click on the 'Schedule an Appointment' tab
- Select 'Pre-procedure COVID-19 Testing/Employee COVID-19 Screening' under 'Tell Us Why You're Coming In' options and answer the questions.
- Follow the prompts to schedule your appointment at the WakeMed Testing Center Clayton or WakeMed Testing Center — Cary. You will be asked to enter the date of your procedure, so please have that handy.

PROCEDURE DATE:

If you do not have a WakeMed MyChart account:

- Please call the MyChart Line at 919-350-2288 to obtain a code. The hours for the MyChart Line are Monday-Friday, 7:30 am to noon and 1 to 6:30 pm.
- Download the MyChart app from the AppStore or Google Play or go to MyChart.wakemed.org.
- Click 'Sign up Now' under 'New User?' to set up your account. Please note that account setup does not happen immediately. A customer service representative will handle your request as soon as possible.
- Follow the steps above to schedule a test.
- Or you can provide documentation of a valid COVID-19 test that you received at your primary care physician's office, an area pharmacy or through a Wake County testing site within 72 hours of your surgery date.
